Sister Mary Charleen Weiler, age 86, passed into the arms of our loving God on Tuesday, October 2, 2025, at Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother Franciscan Courts in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Her niece Lou and the Sisters had been with her these past days.

Sister Charleen, born December 2, 1938, in Athens, Wisconsin, was named and baptized Romilda Ann. She was the second youngest of nine children born the daughter of Clem and Mary Weiler welcomed by five brothers (Raywood, Gerald, Edgar, Vernon and Gordon) and two sisters (Bernice and Elaine). Four years later, another sister, Julitta, would be welcomed into the family. She is survived by two siblings, Gordan and Elaine as well as 23 nieces and nephews.
